Mike Buelter and Scott Sawitski gave information on the upcoming Omro Cycling Classic to be held on July 2nd. This event is part of the WISPORT series. Wheel & Sprocket will be the primary sponsor and OCC has agreed to provide support. This means volunteers will be needed for registration, road guards, etc. This citizens race will start and end at Omro High School. The distance is 40 miles. Up to 400 riders can register. This is a big time cycling event and a great opportunity for our club to get involved. More information will be forthcoming.

OCC has put in a minimum order for 26 cycling jerseys. Anyone interested in getting a short sleeve, sleeveless or the new long sleeve jersey must do so by February 15th at either Oshkosh Cyclery or Wheel & Sprocket. There was also some discussion on OCC T-shirts. There were 18 T-shirts made and sold last year. A new supply needs to be produced this year. Possibility of adding our sponsors to the shirt as well as either the front or back design of our jerseys was suggested. K. Kubiak will pursue this further.

B. Kienert has put together a membership packet that includes the OCC by-laws, registration form, local ride times, e-mail list and OCC jerseys. The committee voted to allocate \$200.00 to produce this packet and have them available at the YMCA, Custom Fitness and both bike shops.

Mention was made of OCC providing support for the Pedal for Prevention of Child Abuse ride that's sponsored by the Hope Center in Oshkosh. K. Kubiak will make contact with this organization for more information.

A complete membership list will be compiled so all members will receive e-mails regarding club activities, news and information.
