Be It Resolved! Meeting Results of April 4th, Now In! Excellent!

- 1) **The 1st Amendment discussion:** It was discussed, with vigor and consensus, that OCC shall remain a sovereign and separate entity from any other cycling entity. It was further discussed, with great consensus, that OCC shall act without bias toward, nor against, any other cycling entity. It was further discussed that OCC shall retain discretionary prerogative to support and cooperate with other cycling entities on projects and events that are consistent with the OCC mission. OCC shall give equal opportunity to all cycling entities with regard to OCC support in those said endeavors. Or something like that. The propose of the amendment is to protect the interests of the entire OCC body, without regard to whether we are Sunni, Shi'ite, or Kurd, metaphorically speaking.
- 2) **Financial Report:** We officially have about \$1000.00 dollars or so, give or take. For a less formal version of this report write to Cclark at cclark2@new.rr.com.
- 3) **Membership Dues - Should we charge annual Membership Dues or not?** The vote carried unanimously with all in favor of having annual dues. There were zero no votes, and zero abstentions noted.
